Concerns brought up to this committee was with the site plan was that the parcel of land has to be fenced for this type of business (storage bldgs). The proposed septic system & water well may have to be relocated to prevent vehicular & frost damage. Also documentation from the Drain Commission should also be submitted at the same time. There were numerous other criteria such as Signage, Driveway Entrance, Parking Spaces, Width of Aisles, East Gate location & revised building widths that has to be met.
