ADD: Committeeperson Wahr stated that the 'moderate' use plan pertaining to the Eagle Point Property is in effect & multi-residential units do not conform to this guideline.

Tonight's meeting was an informational request by Michigan Inter. Speedway in regard to Township guidelines pertaining to their proposed campsite project for the 2003 season. They presented what they wanted to do, proposed expectations, security & fire measures.
