**IV. Applicant Signature**

I will cooperate with the Plumbing Inspector and assume the responsibility to arrange for necessary inspections.
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**\*\*Inspection fees are \$65.00 per inspection plus a non-refundable \$25.00 fee for administration.\*\***

Grinder cans cannot and will not be started up until the following is completed: 1. Electrical Inspection has been completed and approved for the house control panel to the can control panel 2. Plumbing Inspection has been completed and approved for hook-up from the house to the grinder can.

Once these are approved, please contact the Township to schedule your grinder can start-up. Please note: Failure to follow rules for the sewer installation/start-up process will result in additional fees and charges should extra work be required at your property above the amounts quoted for the installation. Also, if appropriate steps are not taken to schedule the start-up and there is a problem with the sewer (i.e. a back-up in your basement because the system was never turned on) you are responsible for all charges related to the problem.
